

OBITUARY Bennie Hendrix Ralls JULY 24, 1931 - NOVEMBER 20, 2022

Bennie Hendrix Ralls passed away November 20,2022 at home after a lengthy illness. A memorial service will be held in the Chapel at First Presbyterian Church in Greensboro on Saturday December 3rd at 3:00pm. The family will receive visitors in the Redhead Hall at the church following the service.

Bennie was born in Concord, North Carolina in July 24, 1931. She moved to Greensboro to attend UNC Women's College – now UNC-G.
