

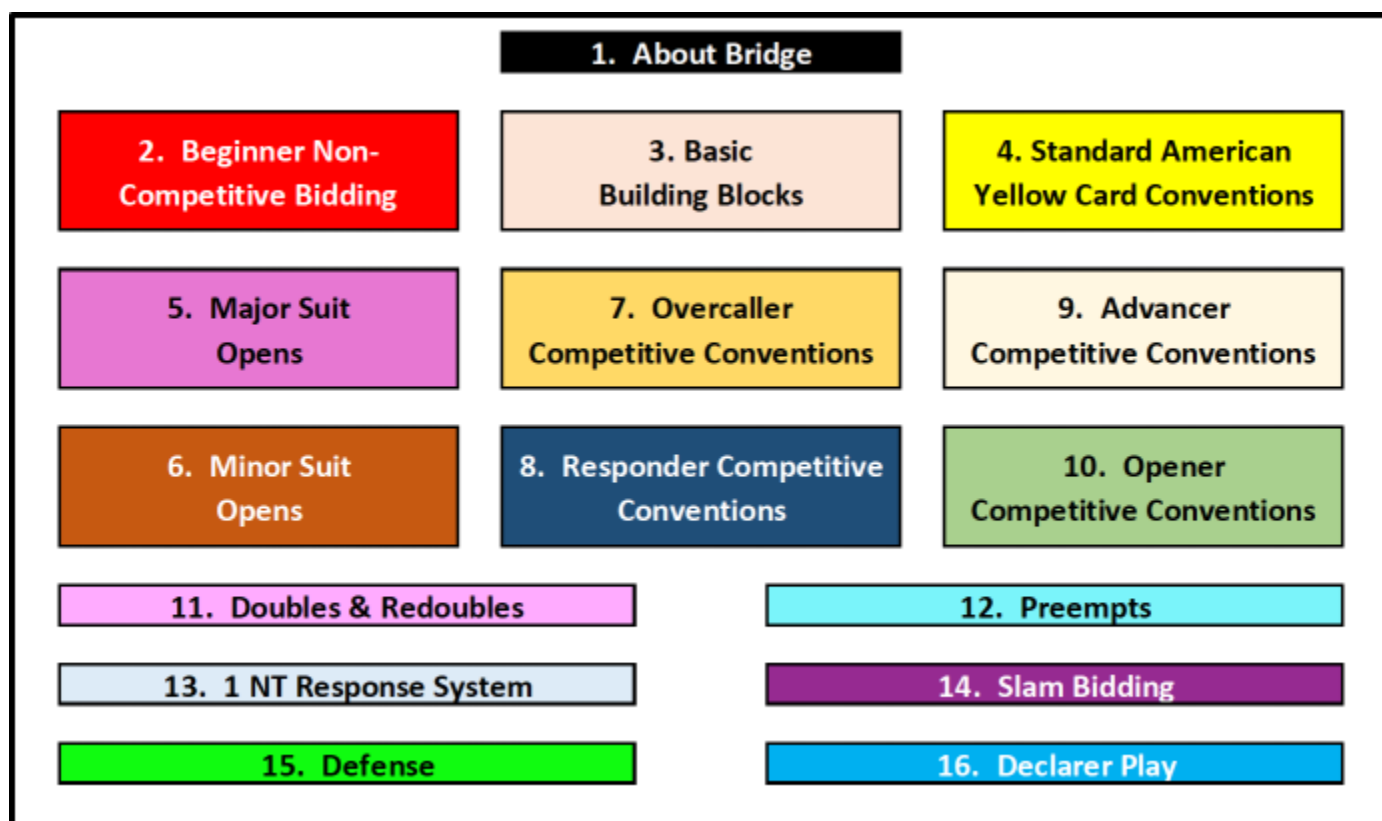

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We made great progress in 2021. We have nearly completed our Bridge Roadmap Atlas. The Atlas contains lesson roadmaps in 16 bridge subject areas. Each roadmap video identifies the conventions that are used and the sequence in which they should be learned.



There are currently 63 recorded lesson videos available:

- Beginner Course 7 Free Non-Competitive Bidding lessons
- Basic Concept 15 Free Bridge Concept lessons
- Intermediate Course 13 of 28 Standard American Yellow Convention Card lessons
- 1NT Response System 12 lessons detailing the entire system
- Defense –Opening Leads 8 lessons in the segment
- Defense – 3rd Hand play 8 lessons in the segment
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When you register for a recorded lesson (free or otherwise), you receive an email that contains links to the lesson handout and the recorded lesson video. Registration is easy. For free or donation lessons, all that is required is your name and email address. For those with a registration fee, you may pay by credit card, debit card, or Paypal.

All 28 on-demand recorded SAYC lessons will be available by the start of 2022. The following figure shows the lessons in the course.
